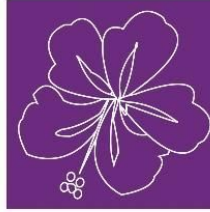

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PLANT & FLOWER GROWERS MARKET BOOTH INFORMATION

Aloha! We would like to invite you to participate in our 27th Annual Haiku Ho'olaule'a & Flower Festival on Saturday, April 25, 2020 from 9am-4pm. This is an admission-free public community event and fundraiser to benefit Haiku Elementary School, Haiku Boys & Girls Club and the Haiku Community Association. As we are expecting over 7,000 attendees, we wish to ensure that we highlight our local farms. **Please join us!**

Here is how it works...

PLANTS, PRODUCE AND CUT FLOWERS

Please note that these booths are dedicated to agricultural ventures from all areas of Maui County for the sale of plants, produce, and cut flowers ONLY. If you wish to sell food or crafts, please contact the Event Office at Haikuhoolaulea@gmail.com for the correct application.

BOOTH SPACE

- Reserved 10'x10' uncovered space at \$75 per space, if application received by March 25. \$100 if received after March 25.
- You are welcome to purchase more than 1 space, just notate it on the form attached.
- Booth space is based on a first come, first served basis. Due to the popularity of the event and limited space available, we strongly recommend you send in your request as soon as possible.
- A Confirmation receipt will be emailed to you after your registration with full payment is received.
- Your booth space assignment will be advised on your arrival to the event.
- The event will take place Haiku rain or shine!

PAYMENT

- Your booth registration form with payment is due no later than March 25, 2020 and is non-refundable.
- Reminder that space is based on a first come, first served basis. Registration forms will not be processed without payment.
- You are welcome to make payment via check.
- If your application is received March 25, 2020 or beyond and we still have booth space available, the fee will increase by \$25 per booth. Returned checks will be charged a \$25 processing fee.

EQUIPMENT

You are required to bring all of your own equipment i.e. tables, linens, chairs, cash and wireless credit card processing machines, etc.

PTA FARMERS MARKET

A donation of plants, produce or cut flowers to our PTA Farmer's Market is strongly recommended. Please note your donation on the form attached. You may bring your donation on the day of the festival and drop off at the PTA Farmer's Market booth.

LOAD-IN/LOAD-OUT & PARKING

Load-In Time: 6:00am – 8:15am ONLY. No vehicles will be allowed on the festival grounds between 8:15am and 4:15pm.

You will be able to unload at your booth and will then need to move your vehicle. **Load-Out Time: At 4:15pm ONLY.** All vendors must remain in their booths until the end of the event. *(Please do not plan to leave early as it undermines the quality and success of the event.)*
